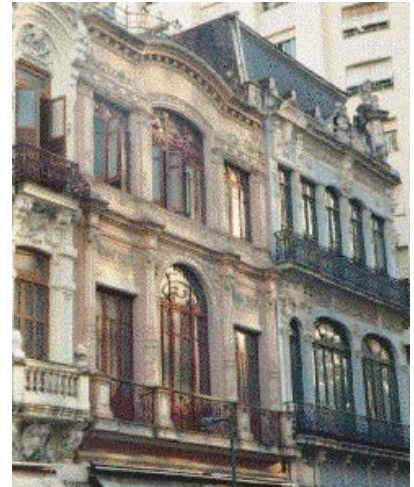


# AMAZING BRAZIL AND ARGENTINA SOUNDS AND FLAVORS OF LATIN AMERICAN JUDAISM

**THURSDAY, JULY 3:** Guided tour of Buenos Aires. Meeting with a noted Argentine economist. Dinner with Jewish community leaders at one of the city's finest restaurants.

**FRIDAY, JULY 4:** Tour of sites of Jewish interest in Buenos Aires. Attend vibrant Latin Shabbat services at the historic Libertad Synagogue, followed by dinner with prominent Argentine Jewish leader Rabbi Sergio Bergman and members of the community.

**SATURDAY, JULY 5:** Shabbat morning services at NCI-Emanuel, Argentina's first Reform synagogue. Afternoon free. Optional tango show in the evening.

**SUNDAY, JULY 6:** Arrive in São Paulo. Tour of the city. Visit CIP, the largest Progressive congregation in Latin America.

**MONDAY, JULY 7:** Visit Jewish points of interest in São Paulo. In the late afternoon, fly to Belo Horizonte or Porto Alegre.

**TUESDAY, JULY 8:** Tour Ouro Preto and meet with leaders of CIM in Belo Horizonte; or tour Porto Alegre and meet leaders of the city's two Progressive congregations. Dinner with congregation leaders in each city.

**WEDNESDAY, JULY 9:** Fly to Rio de Janeiro. Tour the city. In the late afternoon, meet leaders of the ARI congregation, followed by dinner with guests at a famous Rio restaurant.

**THURSDAY, JULY 10:** Free morning to explore Rio. The Conference of Jewish Communities of Latin America begins in the evening.

**FRIDAY-SATURDAY, JULY 11-12:** Attend the Conference of Jewish Communities of Latin America.

**SUNDAY, JULY 13:** The Conference of Jewish Communities of Latin America concludes.

We will meet in Buenos Aires on the morning of July 3. Sol International Tours can help you get the best rates on flights to and from South America, or you can make your own arrangements. \$2950 per person double occupancy (single supplement \$900) includes local airfare within Argentina and Brazil, hotel accommodations with breakfast, all ground transportation with luggage assistance, all listed tours, entrance fees during tours, all meals listed on the itinerary, and local taxes. International air transportation, visa for travel to Brazil (required of U.S. citizens), passport fee or pre-departure expenses, airport departure taxes, meals not specified on the itinerary, tips to drivers and guides, and expenses of a personal nature are not included.
